All other nonpublic students should complete and return this to Cape Central High School before 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 10. Students must be age appropriate high school juniors (11th grade) living in the Cape Girardeau Public School District.

- ACT registration for nonpublic students will be held prior to testing. Students must bring an official state identification (ex. Driver's license) or school issued identification card. It is also recommended that you bring a copy of your high school transcript.
- The ACT for nonpublic students will be administered beginning on Wednesday, April 19, 2017 at Cape Central High School.
